Matthew 4:1

¶ Then was Jesus **led up of the Spirit** into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

Matthew 10:20

For it is not ye that speak, but the **Spirit** of your **Father** which speaketh in you.

Matthew 12:18

Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my Spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles.

Mark 1:8

"I indeed baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

Mark 1:10

And immediately, coming up from the water, He saw the heavens parting and the **Spirit** descending upon Him like a dove.

Luke 1:15

"For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be **filled with the Holy Spirit**, even **from his mother's womb**.

Luke 1:17

"He will also go before Him **in the spirit and power of Elijah**, `to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,' and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord."

Luke 1:35

And the angel answered and said to her, "[The] Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

Luke 1:41

And it happened, when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, that the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit.

Luke 1:67

¶ Now his father **Zacharias was filled with the Holy Spirit**, and prophesied, saying:

Luke 1:80

So the child grew and **became strong in spirit**, and was in the deserts till the day of his manifestation to Israel.

Luke 2:25

¶ And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and **the Holy Spirit was upon him**.

Luke 2:40

And the Child grew and **became strong in spirit**, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him.

Luke 3:16

John answered, saying to all, "I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose. **He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.**

Luke 3:22

And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased."

Luke 4:1

¶ Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

Luke 4:14

¶ Then Jesus returned in the **power of the Spirit** to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region.

Luke 11:13

"If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will [your] heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

John 1:32

And John bore witness, saying, "I saw the **Spirit descending from heaven like a dove**, and He remained upon Him.

John 1:33

"I did not know Him, but He who sent me to baptize with water said to me, `Upon whom you see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, this is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.'

John 3:5

Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is **born of water and the Spirit**, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

John 3:6

"That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

John 3:8

"The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is **born of the Spirit**."

John 3:34

"For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure.

John 4:23

"But the hour is coming, and now is, when **the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth**; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

John 4:24

"God [is] Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

John 6:63

"It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and [they] are life.

John 7:39

But this He spoke concerning the **Spirit**, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet [given], because Jesus was not yet glorified.

John 14:17

"the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

John 14:26

"But the **Helper, the Holy Spirit**, whom the **Father will send in My name**, **He will teach you all things**, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

John 15:26

¶ "But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, **the Spirit of truth** who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me.

John 16:13

"However, when **He, the Spirit of truth**, has come, **He will guide you into all truth**; for **He will not speak on His own** [authority], but **whatever He hears He will speak**; and He will tell you things to come.

John 20:22

And when He had said this, He breathed on [them], and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

Acts 1:2

until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen,

Acts 1:5

"for John truly baptized with water, but **you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit** not many days from now."

Acts 1:8

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Acts 2:4

And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:17 `

And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams.

Acts 2:33

"Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.

Acts 2:38

Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and **you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit**.

Acts 4:8

Then **Peter**, **filled with the Holy Spirit**, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel:

Acts 4:31

And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all **filled with the Holy Spirit**, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Acts 5:3

But Peter said, "Ananias, why has **Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit** and keep back [part] of the price of the land for yourself?

Acts 5:32

"And we are His witnesses to these things, and [so] also [is] the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him."

Acts 6:3

"Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of [good] reputation, **full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom**, whom we may appoint over this business;

Acts 6:5

And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose **Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit**, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch,

Acts 6:10

And they were not able to resist the **wisdom and the Spirit by which he spoke**.

Acts 7:51

¶ "[You] stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always resist the Holy Spirit; as your fathers [did], so [do] you.

Acts 7:55

But he, being **full of the Holy Spirit**, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God,

Acts 8:15

who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might **receive the Holy Spirit**.

Acts 8:17

Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

Acts 8:18

And when Simon saw that through the laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Spirit was given, he offered them money,

Acts 8:19

saying, "Give me this power also, that anyone on whom I lay hands may **receive the Holy Spirit."**

Acts 9:17

And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be **filled with the Holy Spirit**."

Acts 9:31

Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the **comfort of the Holy Spirit**, they were multiplied.

Acts 10:38

"how God <u>anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit</u> and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Acts 10:44

¶ While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.

Acts 10:45

And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also.

Acts 10:47

"Can anyone forbid water, that these should not <u>be baptized who have received</u> the Holy Spirit just as we [have]?"

Acts 11:15

"And as I began to speak, the <u>Holy Spirit fell upon them</u>, as upon us at the beginning.

Acts 11:16

"Then I remembered the word of the Lord, how He said, 'John indeed baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit.'

Acts 11:24

For he was a good man, **full of the Holy Spirit and of faith**. And a great many people were added to the Lord.

Acts 13:9

Then Saul, who also [is called] Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked intently at him

Acts 13:52

And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 15:8

"So God, who knows the heart, acknowledged them by giving them the Holy Spirit, just as [He did] to us,

Acts 17:16

¶ Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was provoked within him when he saw that the city was given over to idols.

Acts 18:5

When Silas and Timothy had come from Macedonia, **Paul was compelled by the Spirit**, and testified to the Jews [that] Jesus [is] the Christ.

Acts 18:25

This man had been instructed in the way of the Lord; and being **fervent in spirit**, he spoke and taught accurately the things of the Lord, though he knew only the baptism of John.

Acts 19:2

he said to them, "Did you **receive the Holy Spirit** when you believed?" So they said to him, "We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit."

Acts 19:6

And when **Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them**, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

Acts 19:21

¶ When these things were accomplished, Paul purposed in the Spirit, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, "After I have been there, I must also see Rome."

Acts 20:22

"And see, now **I go bound in the spirit** to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there,

Romans 1:9

For God is my witness, whom I **serve with my spirit** in the gospel of His Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers,

Romans 5:5

Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been **poured out in our** hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Romans 8:1

¶ There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not

walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:2

For the **law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus** has made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:4

that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:5

For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.

Romans 8:6

For to be carnally minded is death, but to be **spiritually minded is life and peace**.

Romans 8:9

But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.

Romans 8:10

¶ And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but **the Spirit is life because** of righteousness.

Romans 8:11

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

Romans 8:13

For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

Romans 8:14

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

Romans 8:15

For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you **received the Spirit of adoption** by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father."

Romans 8:16

The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

Romans 8:23

Not only that, but we also who have the **firstfruits of the Spirit**, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, **eagerly waiting for the adoption**, **the redemption of our body**.

Romans 8:26

¶ Likewise **the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses**. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but **the Spirit Himself makes intercession** for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

Romans 8:27

Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

Romans 9:1

¶ I tell the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit,

Romans 11:8

Just as it is written: "God has given them a spirit of stupor, Eyes that they should not see And ears that they should not hear, To this very day."

Romans 12:11

not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;

Romans 14:17

for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but **righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit**.

Romans 15:13

¶ Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Romans 15:16

that I might be a minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering of the Gentiles might be acceptable, **sanctified by the Holy Spirit**.

Romans 15:19

in mighty signs and wonders, by the **power of the Spirit of God**, so that from Jerusalem and round about to Illyricum I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

Romans 15:30

¶ Now I beg you, brethren, through the Lord Jesus Christ, and through the **love of the Spirit**, that you strive together with me in prayers to God for me,

1 Corinthians 2:4

And my speech and **my preaching** were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but **in demonstration of the Spirit and of power**,

1 Corinthians 2:10

But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.

1 Corinthians 2:11

For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one **knows the things of God except the Spirit of God**.

1 Corinthians 2:12

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but **the Spirit who is from God, that we might know** the things that have been freely given to us by God.

1 Corinthians 2:13

These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which **the Holy Spirit teaches**, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

1 Corinthians 2:14

But the **natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God**, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know [them], because they are spiritually discerned.

1 Corinthians 3:16

¶ Do you not know that you are the temple of God and [that] the **Spirit of God dwells** in you?

1 Corinthians 6:11

And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

1 Corinthians 6:17

But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit [with Him].

1 Corinthians 6:19

Or do you not know that **your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit** [who is] in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

1 Corinthians 6:20

For you were bought at a price; therefore **glorify God in your body and in your spirit**, which are God's.

1 Corinthians 7:40

But she is happier if she remains as she is, according to my judgment----and I think I also have the Spirit of God.

1 Corinthians 12:3

Therefore I make known to you that **no one speaking by the Spirit of God calls**Jesus accursed, and no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 12:4

There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

- 1 Corinthians 12:7-13
- 7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit [of all]:
- 8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of

knowledge through the same Spirit,

- 9 to another **faith by the same Spirit**, to another **gifts of healings by the same Spirit**.
- 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits,
 - to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.
- 11 But **one and the same Spirit works all these things**, distributing to each one individually as He wills.
- 12 ¶ For even as the body is one and [yet] has many members, and all the members of the
 - body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ.
- 13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body----whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free----and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.

1 Corinthians 14:2

For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands [him]; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.

1 Corinthians 16:18

For they **refreshed my spirit** and yours. Therefore acknowledge such men.

2 Corinthians 1:22

who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

2 Corinthians 3:17

Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord [is], there [is] liberty.

2 Corinthians 5:5

Now He who has prepared us for this very thing [is] God, who also has given us the Spirit as a guarantee.

2 Corinthians 11:4

For if he who comes preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or **[if] you receive a different spirit which you have not received**, or a different gospel which you have not accepted----you may well put up with it!

2 Corinthians 12:18

I urged Titus, and sent our brother with [him]. Did Titus take advantage of you? Did we not **walk in the same spirit**? Did [we] not [walk] in the same steps?

2 Corinthians 13:14

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the **communion of the Holy Spirit [be] with you all. Amen**.

Galatians 3:2

This only I want to learn from you: Did you **receive the Spirit** by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Galatians 3:14

that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Galatians 4:6

And because you are sons, **God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts**, crying out, "Abba, Father!"

Galatians 5:5

For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.

Galatians 5:16

I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Galatians 5:17

For the **flesh lusts against the Spirit**, and **the Spirit against the flesh**; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

Galatians 5:18

But if you are **led by the Spirit**, you are not under the law.

Galatians 5:22

But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Galatians 5:25

If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

Galatians 6:1

¶ Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who [are] spiritual restore such a one

in a **spirit of gentleness**, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.

Galatians 6:8

For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but **he who sows to the**Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.

Ephesians 1:13

In Him you also [trusted], after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were **sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise**,

Ephesians 1:17

that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,

Ephesians 2:22

in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

Ephesians 3:16

that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man,

Ephesians 4:3

endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Ephesians 4:4

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling;

Ephesians 4:23

and be renewed in the spirit of your mind,

Ephesians 4:30

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

Ephesians 5:9

(for the **fruit of the Spirit** is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth),

Ephesians 5:18

And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,

Ephesians 6:18

praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints----

Philippians 1:19

For I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayer and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ.

1 Thessalonians 1:5

For our **gospel** did not come to you in word only, but also **in power, and in the Holy Spirit** and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake.

1 Thessalonians 4:8

Therefore he who rejects [this] does not reject man, but **God, who has also given us His Holy Spirit.**

1 Thessalonians 5:19 Do not quench the Spirit.

1 Timothy 4:1

¶ Now **the Spirit expressly says** that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,

2 Timothy 1:14

That good thing which was committed to you, **keep by the Holy Spirit who dwells in us.**

Titus 3:5

not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,

Hebrews 6:4

For [it is] impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become **partakers** of the Holy Spirit,

Hebrews 10:15

But the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us; for after He had said before,

James 4:5

Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously"?

1 Peter 1:11

searching what, or what manner of time, the **Spirit of Christ who was in them** was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.

1 Peter 1:22

Since you have purified your souls in **obeying the truth through the Spirit** in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart,

1 Peter 4:6

For this reason the gospel was preached also to those who are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but **live according to God in the spirit**.

1 Peter 4:14

If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed [are you], for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified.

2 Peter 1:21

for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke [as they were] moved by the Holy Spirit.

1 John 3:24

Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.

1 John 4:1

¶ Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

1 John 4:6

We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error.

1 John 4:13

By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because **He has given us of His Spirit**.

Jude 1:19

These are sensual persons, who cause divisions, not having the Spirit.

Jude 1:20

But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, **praying in the Holy Spirit**,

Revelation 1:10

I was **in the Spirit** on the Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a loud voice, as of a trumpet,
