Matthew 16:24 Exegesis

DENY

720 ἀρνεομαι *arneomai* ar-neh'-om-ahee

perhaps from 1 (as a negative particle) and the middle voice of 4483; TDNT-1:469,79; v to deny, **say no**:—

NAS-denied (10), denies (5), deny (12), denying (2), **disowned** (3), **refused** (1).

AV-deny 29, refuse 2; 31

1) to deny

2) to deny someone

2a) to deny one's self

2a1) to **disregard** his own interests or to **prove false to himself**

2a2) act entirely unlike himself

Matthew 10:33

"But whoever **denies** <720 *arneomai*> Me before men, I will also **deny** <720 *arneomai*> him before My Father who is in heaven.

Matthew 26:70

But he **denied** <720 *arneomai*> *it* before them all, saying, "I do not know what you are talking about."

Matthew 26:72

And again he **denied** <720 *arneomai*> *it* with an oath, "I do not know the man."

Mark 14:68

But he **denied** <720 *arneomai*> *it*, saying, "I neither know nor understand what you are talking about." And he went out onto the porch, and a rooster crowed.

Mark 14:70

But again he **denied** <720 *arneomai*> *it*. And after a little while the bystanders were again saying to Peter, "Surely you are *one* of them, for you are a Galilean too."

Luke 8:45

And Jesus said, "Who is the one who touched Me?" And while they were all **denying** <720 *arneomai*> *it*, Peter said, "Master, the people are crowding and pressing in on You."

Luke 9:23

And He was saying to *them* all, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must **deny** <720

arneomai> himself, and take up his cross daily and follow Me.

Luke 12:9

but he who **denies** <720 **arneomai**> Me before men will be **denied** <533 **aparneomai**> before the angels of God.

Luke 22:57

But he **denied** <720 **arneomai**> *it*, saying, "Woman, I do not know Him."

John 1:20

And he confessed and did not **deny** <720 **arneomai**>, but confessed, "I am not the Christ."

John 13:38

Jesus *answered, "Will you lay down your life for Me? Truly, truly, I say to you, a rooster will not crow until you **deny** <720 **arneomai**> Me three times.

John 18:25

Now Simon Peter was standing and warming himself. So they said to him, "You are not also *one* of His disciples, are you?" He **denied** <720 **arneomai**> *it*, and said, "I am not."

John 18:27

Peter then **denied** <720 **arneomai**> *it* again, and immediately a rooster crowed.

Acts 3:13

"The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified His servant Jesus, *the one* whom you delivered and **disowned** <720 **arneomai**> in the presence of Pilate, when he had decided to release Him.

Acts 3:14

"But you **disowned** <720 **arneomai**> the Holy and Righteous One and asked for a murderer to be granted to you,

Acts 4:16

saying, "What shall we do with these men? For the fact that a noteworthy miracle has taken place through them is apparent to all who live in Jerusalem, and we cannot **deny** <720 **arneomai**> *it*.

Acts 7:35

"This Moses whom they **disowned** <720 **arneomai**>, saying, 'WHO MADE YOU A RULER AND A JUDGE?' is the one whom God sent *to be* both a ruler and a deliverer with the help of the angel who appeared to him in the thorn bush.

1 Timothy 5:8

But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has **denied** <720 **arneomai**> the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

Matthew 16:24 Exegesis

2 Timothy 2:12

If we endure, we will also reign with Him; If we **deny <720 arneomai>** Him, He also will **deny <720 arneomai>** us;

2 Timothy 2:13

If we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot **deny <720 arneomai>** Himself.

2 Timothy 3:5

holding to a form of godliness, although they have **denied <720 arneomai>** its power; Avoid such men as these.

Titus 1:16

They profess to know God, but by *their* deeds they **deny <720 arneomai>** Him, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed.

Titus 2:12

instructing us to **deny <720 arneomai>** ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age,

Hebrews 11:24

By faith Moses, when he had grown up, **refused <720 arneomai>** to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,

2 Peter 2:1

But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will also be false teachers among you, who will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even **denying <720 arneomai>** the Master who bought them, bringing swift destruction upon themselves.

1 John 2:22-23

22 Who is the liar but the one who **denies <720 arneomai>** that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, the one who **denies <720 arneomai>** the Father and the Son.
23 Whoever **denies <720 arneomai>** the Son does not have the Father; the one who confesses the Son has the Father also.

Jude 1:4

For certain persons have crept in unnoticed, those who were long beforehand marked out for this condemnation, ungodly persons who turn the grace of our God into licentiousness and **deny <720 arneomai>** our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ.

Revelation 2:13

'I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is; and you hold fast My name, and did not **deny <720 arneomai>** My faith even in the days of Antipas, My witness, My faithful one, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells.

Revelation 3:8

'I know your deeds. Behold, I have put before you an open door which no one can shut,

because you have a little power, and have kept My word, and have not **denied <720 arneomai>** My name.

1) to deny

Matthew 16:24

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must **deny <533 aparneomai>** himself, and take up his cross and follow Me.

Matthew 26:34

Jesus said to him, "Truly I say to you that this very night, before a rooster crows, you will **deny <533 aparneomai>** Me three times."

Matthew 26:35

Peter *said to Him, "Even if I have to die with You, I will not **deny <533 aparneomai>** You." All the disciples said the same thing too.

Matthew 26:75

And Peter remembered the word which Jesus had said, "Before a rooster crows, you will **deny <533 aparneomai>** Me three times." And he went out and wept bitterly.

Mark 8:34

And He summoned the crowd with His disciples, and said to them, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must **deny <533 aparneomai>** himself, and take up his cross and follow Me.

Mark 14:30

And Jesus *said to him, "Truly I say to you, that this very night, before a rooster crows twice, you yourself will **deny <533 aparneomai>** Me three times."

Mark 14:31

But *Peter* kept saying insistently, "Even if I have to die with You, I will not **deny <533 aparneomai>** You!" And they all were saying the same thing also.

Mark 14:72

Immediately a rooster crowed a second time. And Peter remembered how Jesus had

made the remark to him, "Before a rooster crows twice, you will deny **<533 aparneomai>** Me three times." And he began to weep.

Luke 12:9

but he who **denies <720 arneomai>** Me before men will be **denied <533 aparneomai>** before the angels of God.

And He said, "I say to you, Peter, the rooster will not crow today until you have **denied <533 aparneomai>** three times that you know Me."

Luke 22:61

The Lord turned and looked at Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how He had told him, "Before a rooster crows today, you will **deny <533 aparneomai>** Me three times."

NAS-confess (2), confessed (1), confessing (2), consented (1), give praise (2), praise (2).

At that time Jesus said, "I **praise <1843 exomologeō>** You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and intelligent and have revealed them to infants.

Mark 1:5

And all the country of Judea was going out to him, and all the people of Jerusalem; and they were being baptized by him in the Jordan River, **confessing <1843 exomologeō>** their sins.

Matthew 16:24 Exegesis

Luke 10:21

At that very time He rejoiced greatly in the Holy Spirit, and said, "I **praise <1843 exomologeo>** You, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and intelligent and have revealed them to infants. Yes, Father, for this way was well-pleasing in Your sight.

Luke 22:6

So he **consented <1843 exomologeo>**, and *began* seeking a good opportunity to betray Him to them apart from the crowd.

Acts 19:18

Many also of those who had believed kept coming, **confessing <1843 exomologeo>** and disclosing their practices.

Romans 14:11

For it is written, "AS I LIVE, SAYS THE LORD, EVERY KNEE SHALL BOW TO ME, AND EVERY TONGUE SHALL **GIVE PRAISE <1843 exomologeo>** TO GOD."

Romans 15:9

and for the Gentiles to glorify God for His mercy; as it is written, "THEREFORE I WILL **GIVE PRAISE <1843 exomologeo>** TO YOU AMONG THE GENTILES, AND I WILL SING TO YOUR NAME."

Philippians 2:11

and that every tongue will **confess <1843 exomologeo>** that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

James 5:16

Therefore, **confess <1843 exomologeo>** your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

from a compound of the base of **3674** and **3056**; TDNT-5:199,687; v (*of one mind*); to speak the same, to agree:—

NAS-acknowledge (2), admit (1), assured (1), confess (6), confessed (4), confesses (6), confessing (1), declare (1), give thanks (1), made (1), profess (1), promised (1).

AV-confess 17, profess 3, promise 1, give thanks 1, confession is made 1, acknowledgeth 1; 24

1) by consent of all, confessedly, **without controversy**

Matthew 7:23

"And then I will **declare <3670 homologeō>** to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

Matthew 10:32

"Therefore everyone who **confesses <3670 homologeō>** Me before men, I will also

confess <3670 homologeo> him before My Father who is in heaven.

Matthew 14:7

so *much* that he **promised** <3670 homologeo> with an oath to give her whatever she asked.

Luke 12:8

"And I say to you, everyone who **confesses** <3670 homologeo> Me before men, the Son of Man will **confess** <3670 homologeo> him also before the angels of God;

John 1:20

And he **confessed** <3670 homologeo> and did not deny, but **confessed** <3670 homologeo>, "I am not the Christ."

John 9:22

His parents said this because they were afraid of the Jews; for the Jews had already agreed that if anyone **confessed** <3670 homologeo> Him to be Christ, he was to be put out of the synagogue.

John 12:42

Nevertheless many even of the rulers believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they were not **confessing** <3670 homologeo> Him, for fear that they would be put out of the synagogue;

Acts 7:17

"But as the time of the promise was approaching which God had **assured** <3670 homologeo> to Abraham, the people increased and multiplied in Egypt,

Acts 23:8

For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, nor an angel, nor a spirit, but the Pharisees **acknowledge** <3670 homologeo> them all.

Acts 24:14

"But this I **admit** <3670 homologeo> to you, that according to the Way which they call a sect I do serve the God of our fathers, believing everything that is in accordance with the Law and that is written in the Prophets;

Romans 10:9-10

9 that if you **confess** <3670 homologeo> with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;
10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he **confesses** <3670 homologeo>, resulting in salvation.

2 Corinthians 9:13

Because of the proof given by this ministry, they will glorify God for *your* obedience to

your **confession <3671 homologia>** of the gospel of Christ and for the liberality of your contribution to them and to all,

1 Timothy 3:16

By **common confession <3672 homologoumenos>**, great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh, Was vindicated in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Proclaimed among the nations, Believed on in the world, Taken up in glory.

1 Timothy 6:12

Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and you **made <3670 homologeō>** the good **confession <3671 homologia>** in the presence of many witnesses.

1 Timothy 6:13

I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified the good **confession <3671 homologia>** before Pontius Pilate,

Titus 1:16

They **profess <3670 homologeō>** to know God, but by *their* deeds they deny *Him*, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed.

Hebrews 3:1

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our **confession <3671 homologia>**;

Hebrews 4:14

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our **confession <3671 homologia>**.

Hebrews 10:23

Let us hold fast the **confession <3671 homologia>** of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;

Hebrews 11:13

All these died in faith, without receiving the promises, but having seen them and having welcomed them from a distance, and having **confessed <3670 homologeō>** that they were strangers and exiles on the earth.

Hebrews 13:15

Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that **give thanks <3670 homologeō>** to His name.

1 John 1:9

If we **confess <3670 homologeō>** our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 16:24 Exegesis

1 John 2:23

Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father; the one who **confesses <3670 homologueo>** the Son has the Father also.

1 John 4:2-3

2 By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that **confesses <3670 homologueo>** that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God;

3 and every spirit that does not **confess <3670 homologueo>** Jesus is not from God; this is the *spirit* of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world.

1 John 4:15

Whoever **confesses <3670 homologueo>** that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.

2 John 1:7

For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not **acknowledge <3670 homologueo>** Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the antichrist.

Revelation 3:5

'He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will **confess <3670 homologueo>** his name before My Father and before His angels.
