The Gospel

Introduction

Gospel literally means “Good News.” What’s the good news? In a word ... Messiah! Messiah is the Anointed One, God with Us and that person is Jesus! Messiah and Christ are the exact same words with Messiah being the Hebrew and Christ being the Greek translations.

The person and message of Jesus is the Good News of the prophesied messiah. The gospel is a message of both Old and New Testaments. Let’s examine the New Testament teaching on the gospel.

New Testament Exegesis

and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>."

"For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the **gospel's** <2098 euaggelion> will save it.

Soon afterwards, He *began* going around from one city and village to another, proclaiming and **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> the kingdom of God. The twelve were with Him,

Departing, they *began* going throughout the villages, **preaching the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> and healing everywhere.

Luke 16:16

"The Law and the Prophets *were proclaimed* until John; since that time the **gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> of the kingdom of God has been **preached** <2097 euaggelizo>, and everyone is forcing his way into it.

Luke 20:1

On one of the days while He was teaching the people in the temple and **preaching the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo>, the chief priests and the scribes with the elders confronted *Him*,

Acts 5:42

And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they kept right on teaching and **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> Jesus as the Christ.

Therefore, those who had been scattered went about **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> the word.

But when they believed Philip **preaching the good news** <2097 euaggelizo> about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were being baptized, men and women alike.

So, when they had solemnly testified and spoken the word of the Lord, they started back to Jerusalem, and were **preaching the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> to many villages of the Samaritans.

Acts 8:35

Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning from this Scripture he **preached** <2097 euaggelizo> Jesus to him.

Acts 8:40

But Philip found himself at Azotus, and as he passed through he kept **preaching the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> to all the cities until he came to Caesarea.

Acts 10:36

"The word which He sent to the sons of Israel, **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> peace through Jesus Christ (He is Lord of all)—

Acts 11:20

But there were some of them, men of Cyprus and Cyrene, who came to Antioch and *began* speaking to the Greeks also, **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> the Lord Jesus.

Acts 13:32

"And we **preach** <2097 euaggelizo> to you the **good news** <2097 euaggelizo> of the promise made to the fathers,

and there they continued to **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo>.

Acts 14:15

and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We are also men of the same nature as you, and **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> to you that you should turn from these vain things to a living God, WHO MADE THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH AND THE SEA AND ALL THAT IS IN THEM.

Acts 14:21

After they had **preached the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> to that city and had made many disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch,

Acts 15:7

After there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, "Brethren, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth the

Gentiles would hear the word of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> and believe.

Acts 15:35

But Paul and Barnabas stayed in Antioch, teaching and **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> with many others also, the word of the Lord.

Acts 16:10

When he had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go into Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> to them.

Acts 17:18

And also some of the Epicurean and Stoic philosophers were conversing with him. Some were saying, "What would this idle babbler wish to say?" Others, "He seems to be a proclaimer of strange deities,"—because he was **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> Jesus and the resurrection.

Acts 20:24

"But I do not consider my life of any account as dear to myself, so that I may finish my course and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify solemnly of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of the grace of God.

Acts 21:8

On the next day we left and came to Caesarea, and entering the house of Philip the **evangelist** <2099 euaggelistes>, who was one of the seven, we stayed with him.

Romans 1:1

Paul, a bond-servant of Christ Jesus, called as an apostle, set apart for the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of God,

Romans 1:9

For God, whom I serve in my spirit in the *preaching of the* **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of His Son, is my witness *as to* how unceasingly I make mention of you,

Romans 1:15

So, for my part, I am eager to **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> to you also who are in Rome.

Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Romans 2:16

on the day when, according to my **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>, God will judge the secrets of men through Christ Jesus.

Romans 10:15

The Gospel

How will they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, "HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO **BRING GOOD NEWS** <2097 euaggelizo> OF GOOD THINGS!"

Romans 10:16

However, they did not all heed the **good news** <2098 euaggelion>; for Isaiah says, "LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT?"

Romans 11:28

From the standpoint of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> they are enemies for your sake, but from the standpoint of *God's* choice they are beloved for the sake of the fathers;

Romans 15:16

to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, ministering as a priest the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of God, so that *my* offering of the Gentiles may become acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.

Romans 15:19

in the power of signs and wonders, in the power of the Spirit; so that from Jerusalem and round about as far as Illyricum I have fully preached the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of Christ.

Romans 15:20

And thus I aspired to **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo>, not where Christ was *already* named, so that I would not build on another man's foundation;

Romans 16:25

Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery which has been kept secret for long ages past,

1 Corinthians 1:17

For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo>, not in cleverness of speech, so that the cross of Christ would not be made void.

1 Corinthians 4:15

For if you were to have countless tutors in Christ, yet *you would* not *have* many fathers, for in Christ Jesus I became your father through the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>.

1 Corinthians 9:12

If others share the right over you, do we not more? Nevertheless, we did not use this right, but we endure all things so that we will cause no hindrance to the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of Christ.

1 Corinthians 9:14

The Gospel

So also the Lord directed those who proclaim the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> to get their living from the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>.

1 Corinthians 9:16

For if I **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo>, I have nothing to boast of, for I am under compulsion; for woe is me if I do not **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo>.

1 Corinthians 9:18

What then is my reward? That, when I **preach the gospel**, <2097 euaggelizo> I may offer the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> without charge, so as not to make full use of my right in the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>.

1 Corinthians 9:23

I do all things for the sake of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>, so that I may become a fellow partaker of it.

1 Corinthians 15:1

Now I make known to you, brethren, the **gospel which I preached** <2097 euaggelizo> to you, which also you received, in which also you stand,

1 Corinthians 15:2

by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I **preached** <2097 euaggelizo> to you, unless you believed in vain.

2 Corinthians 2:12

Now when I came to Troas for the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of Christ and when a door was opened for me in the Lord,

2 Corinthians 4:3

And even if our **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing,

2 Corinthians 4:4

in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

2 Corinthians 8:18

We have sent along with him the brother whose fame in *the things of the* **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> *has spread* through all the churches;

2 Corinthians 9:13

Because of the proof given by this ministry, they will glorify God for *your* obedience to your confession of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of Christ and for the liberality of your contribution to them and to all,

The Gospel

2 Corinthians 10:14

For we are not overextending ourselves, as if we did not reach to you, for we were the first to come even as far as you in the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of Christ;

2 Corinthians 10:16

so as to **preach the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> even to the regions beyond you, *and* not to boast in what has been accomplished in the sphere of another.

2 Corinthians 11:4

For if one comes and preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> which you have not accepted, you bear *this* beautifully.

2 Corinthians 11:7

Or did I commit a sin in humbling myself so that you might be exalted, because I **preached the gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of God to you without charge?

Galatians 1:6

I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>;

Galatians 1:7

which is *really* not another; only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of Christ.

Galatians 1:8

But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should **preach** <2097 euaggelizo> to you a **gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> contrary to what we have **preached** <2097 euaggelizo> to you, he is to be accursed!

Galatians 1:9

As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> to you a **gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!

Galatians 1:11

For I would have you know, brethren, that the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> which was **preached** <2097 euaggelizo> by me is not according to man.

Galatians 1:16

to reveal His Son in me so that I might **preach** <2097 euaggelizo> Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with flesh and blood,

Galatians 1:23

but only, they kept hearing, "He who once persecuted us is now **preaching** <2097 euaggelizo> the faith which he once tried to destroy."

The Gospel

Galatians 2:2

It was because of a revelation that I went up; and I submitted to them the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> which I preach among the Gentiles, but *I did* so in private to those who were of reputation, for fear that I might be running, or had run, in vain.

Galatians 2:5

But we did not yield in subjection to them for even an hour, so that the truth of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> would remain with you.

Galatians 2:7

But on the contrary, seeing that I had been entrusted with the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> to the uncircumcised, just as Peter *had been* to the circumcised

Galatians 2:14

But when I saw that they were not straightforward about the truth of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>, said to Cephas in the presence of all, "If you, being a Jew, live like the Gentiles and not like the Jews, how *is it that* you compel the Gentiles to live like Jews?"

Galatians 3:8

The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, **preached the gospel beforehand** <4283 proeuaggelizomai> to Abraham, *saying*, "ALL THE NATIONS WILL BE BLESSED IN YOU."

Galatians 4:13

but you know that it was because of a bodily illness that I **preached the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> to you the first time;

Ephesians 1:13

In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,

Ephesians 2:17

AND HE CAME AND **PREACHED** <2097 euaggelizo> PEACE TO YOU WHO WERE FAR AWAY, AND PEACE TO THOSE WHO WERE NEAR;

Ephesians 3:6

to be specific, that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> ,

Ephesians 3:8

To me, the very least of all saints, this grace was given, to **preach** <2097 euaggelizo> to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ,

Ephesians 4:11

The Gospel

And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as **evangelists** <2099 euaggelistes>, and some as pastors and teachers,

Ephesians 6:15

and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE **GOSPEL** <2098 euaggelion> OF PEACE;

Ephesians 6:19

and *pray* on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>,

Philippians 1:5

in view of your participation in the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> from the first day until now.

Philippians 1:7

For it is only right for me to feel this way about you all, because I have you in my heart, since both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>, you all are partakers of grace with me.

Philippians 1:12

Now I want you to know, brethren, that my circumstances have turned out for the greater progress of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>,

Philippians 1:16

the latter *do it* out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>;

Philippians 1:27

Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>;

Philippians 2:22

But you know of his proven worth, that he served with me in the furtherance of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> like a child *serv*ing his father.

Philippians 4:3

Indeed, true companion, I ask you also to help these women who have shared my struggle in *the cause* of the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>, together with Clement also and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life.

Philippians 4:15

The Gospel

You yourselves also know, Philippians, that at the first preaching of the **gospel <2098 euaggelion>**, after I left Macedonia, no church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving but you alone;

Colossians 1:5

because of the hope laid up for you in heaven, of which you previously heard in the word of truth, the **gospel <2098 euaggelion>**

Colossians 1:23

if indeed you continue in the faith firmly established and steadfast, and not moved away from the hope of the **gospel <2098 euaggelion>** that you have heard, which was proclaimed in all creation under heaven, and of which I, Paul, was made a minister.

1 Thessalonians 1:5

for our **gospel <2098 euaggelion>** did not come to you in word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.

1 Thessalonians 2:2

but after we had already suffered and been mistreated in Philippi, as you know, we had the boldness in our God to speak to you the **gospel <2098 euaggelion>** of God amid much opposition.

1 Thessalonians 2:4

but just as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the **gospel <2098 euaggelion>**, so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who examines our hearts.

1 Thessalonians 2:8

Having so fond an affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the **gospel <2098 euaggelion>** of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us.

1 Thessalonians 2:9

For you recall, brethren, our labor and hardship, *how* working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the **gospel <2098 euaggelion>** of God.

1 Thessalonians 3:2

and we sent Timothy, our brother and God's fellow worker in the **gospel <2098 euaggelion>** of Christ, to strengthen and encourage you as to your faith,

1 Thessalonians 3:6

But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has **brought us good news <2097 euaggelizo>** of your faith and love, and that you always think kindly of us, longing to see us just as we also long to see you,

2 Thessalonians 1:8

The Gospel

dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of our Lord Jesus.

2 Thessalonians 2:14

It was for this He called you through our **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>, that you may gain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Timothy 1:11

according to the glorious **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of the blessed God, with which I have been entrusted.

2 Timothy 1:8

Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord or of me His prisoner, but join with *me* in suffering for the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> according to the power of God,

2 Timothy 1:10

but now has been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>,

2 Timothy 2:8

Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, descendant of David, according to my **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>,

2 Timothy 4:5

But you, be sober in all things, endure hardship, do the work of an **evangelist** <2099 euaggelistes>, fulfill your ministry.

Philemon 1:13

whom I wished to keep with me, so that on your behalf he might minister to me in my imprisonment for the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion>;

Hebrews 4:2

For indeed we have had **good news preached** <2097 euaggelizo> to us, just as they also; but the word they heard did not profit them, because it was not united by faith in those who heard.

Hebrews 4:6

Therefore, since it remains for some to enter it, and those who formerly had **good news preached** <2097 euaggelizo> to them failed to enter because of disobedience,

1 Peter 1:12

It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, in these things which now have been announced to you through those who **preached the gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things into which angels long to look.

The Gospel

1 Peter 1:25

BUT THE WORD OF THE LORD ENDURES FOREVER." And this is the word which was **preached** <2097 euaggelizo> to you.

1 Peter 4:6

For the **gospel** <2097 euaggelizo> has for this purpose been **preached** <2097 euaggelizo> even to those who are dead, that though they are judged in the flesh as men, they may live in the spirit according to *the will of God*.

For *it is* time for judgment to begin with the household of God; and if *it begins* with us first, what *will be* the outcome for those who do not obey the **gospel** <2098 euaggelion> of God?
